We are pleased to announce that we are now booking in person assessments following Provincial Health Guidelines. Please contact us at 204-586-8395 if you are interested in booking an assessment or want more information. NACM is also accepting referrals for our In-House Healing program for in person services. The requirement for In-House Healing program is to be vaccinated with at least one vaccination shot prior to admission. We understand the choice for vaccination is the applicant's, therefore if the applicant is not vaccinated by choice, they can still participate virtually along with our relatives who are here in person.

Although we have filled our first in person In-House Healing program beginning Monday July 26th, 2021, (which will be coed for this cycle only) we are looking forward to receiving your referrals for upcoming cycles. We have shifted to gender specific program cycles for our In-House Healing Program, and NACM's next in person program will be a women's group on September 7th, 2021 and men's on October 12th, 2021. The date for in-person programming is subject to change in accordance with Provincial Health Guidelines and any unforeseen circumstances. Please continue to check our website for further updates or changes.

Please note, we have updated our referral package and ask that you please disregard all previously printed N.A.C.M forms. Only updated referral packages will be accepted. These can be found on our website at www.nacm.ca under the Programs tab.

The referral packages for in person In House Healing Program must be completed in full and submitted with the medical assessment in order to be considered.

As provincial guidelines are enforced during the global pandemic, there will be new conditions that participants are required to adhere to for admittance into our programming. Please, see the COVID-19 Participant Protocol that will can be found on the website under Programs. This Protocol is applicable to ALL programming at N.A.C.M.
