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CRITERIA

- Applicants must be 18 years or older.
- Applicants must have a minimum of 3 days (72 Hours) of sobriety.
- Applicants will be assessed and recommended to the appropriate program.
- Couples recommended to the Day Program are required to attend a minimum of three (3) counseling sessions prior to admission.
- Women who are seven (7) months pregnant or more will not be accepted.
- Applicants must be willing to commit and participate actively in the program.
- Applicants must attend counseling sessions and three (3) self-help meetings per week prior to program start date.
- Clients who have left, or have been discharged from any program must wait one year before re-applying.
- Applicants who have sexual or violence-related charges or pending charges will not be accepted .
- Applicants who have been diagnosed with or are suspected of having serious mental health issues will not be admitted into the program. They will be referred elsewhere.

Please remember that all Winnipeg residents who wish to enter the Pritchard House Rehabilitation Centre, must attend Outreach meetings prior to admission.

A minimum of two (3) Open Group meetings PER-WEEK is required. Please see the schedule inside this brochure for scheduled meeting dates and time. This requirement must be met. Clients who do not comply may be denied entry to the Pritchard House Program.

If you are sincerely interested in learning how to deal with abuse problems that you are facing, then this requirement should be understandable.
